To accompany our first market we arranged a Gordon Ramsey impersonator, live music, free children's face painting and free caricatures to help make it a fantastic day out.



WHAT IS A BUSINESS IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT (BID)?

There are 350 established BIDs across the U.K including Solihull, Cheltenham, Bath, Brighton, Swansea, Cardiff, Liverpool and Manchester.

A Business Improvement District (BID) is a defined area (such as a town or city centre) in which a compulsory levy is charged on business rate payers in addition to their business rates bill. The BID levy is ringfenced and used for projects and activities which will raise the profile of the area and benefit local businesses.

There is no limit on what projects or services can be provided through a Business Improvement District. The only legal requirement is that it must be something that is in addition to services provided by local authorities such as the Council and Police.

There are 377 BID Members in Sutton Coldfield and the BID boundary starts at Mitre Court on Lichfield Road and runs all the way to the Cinema on Birmingham Road.





The Sutton Coldfield BID is now it it's eleventh year, following the successful ballot of businesses last year which secured a further 5-year term for the BID (2022 – 2027).

The BID operations are overseen by a Board (made up of BID levy payers) and we have a new BID Manager in place from May this year who plans and delivers the BID projects and events.
