BID GUARDIANS

We arranged and funded new BID Guardians to patrol the BID area every Friday and Saturday evening throughout December to cover both the Christmas party season and the World Cup matches. This new project was introduced to provide support for businesses in the night-time economy and help to make Sutton Coldfield a safer place to visit and enjoy in the evening.

Four security guards worked from 4pm – 1am to assist visitors and venues alike. This was a trial project that will be reviewed by the BID Board and the effectiveness of the project will also be discussed with Pubwatch the local Police.

BID PLANS FOR 2023

We are pleased to confirm that we will be continuing with the monthly Farmers and Craft market from March 2023, to be held on the last Sunday of every month from March until November. The market was launched in September last year and ran from September to November. The three markets made a dramatic difference to Sunday footfall in the town centre and boosted sales turnover for local businesses.
