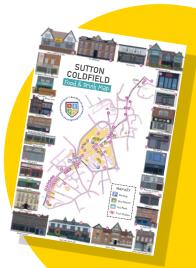
New Website

Fathers day

As an early Father's Day event we brought **Batman and the Batmobile** to Sutton Coldfield town centre on Sunday 11th June. The event attracted thousands of visitors into Sutton Coldfield and was a huge success.



Easter

As an Easter treat we arranged for **Peter Rabbit** himself to meet and greet young visitors on 7th & 8th April. Thank you to Gracechurch Shopping Centre for hosting the famous bunny alongside their Easter craft workshop.



King's Coronation

As a Royal town we felt we had a duty to celebrate the **King's Coronation** on Sunday 7th May. The sun shone and the crowds came out to enjoy the live music, food and drink stalls, free face painting, balloon artist, stilt walkers, royal living statues, bubble-ologist and craft workshop. Our picnic benches created the perfect seating area and it was wonderful to see the event so well attended.



Farmers & Craft Market

Our monthly market goes from strength to strength and we have just held our 7th market since we first launched it back in September 2022. Our market is managed and organised entirely in-house which means we can then reinvest the pitch fees and fund entertainment and activities to support the market which also boosts footfall for local businesses.

At our most recent market on Sunday 25th June we celebrated Armed Forces Day with the hilarious dancing soldiers from the movie Toy Story keeping shoppers entertained.

Our market is on the last Sunday of every month from 10am-3pm along The Parade in Sutton Coldfield town centre. We attract between 30-40 stalls each month and the market will continue as long as it is supported by the local community and shoppers.



Graffiti Removal

We want Sutton Coldfield to be an attractive town centre that is welcoming and clean for the businesses that call Sutton Coldfield home, the thousands of employees that work here and the shoppers and people that visit. We spotted 30 pieces of graffiti throughout the town centre and reported to the two Councils. Unfortunately as the graffiti was on private business premises the Councils were unable to remove so we contracted a private specialist company to remove which they did immediately. We will schedule a further clean after the school summer holidays in September to keep on top of the issue.
