The hospitality industry is struggling nationally so as an early Christmas present we organised and funded Christmas wreath making workshops at local venues in Sutton Coldfield town centre. ## Halloween Cinema

As the cinema in Sutton Coldfield town centre remains closed, we organised and funded a 4-day pop-up open-air cinema on The Parade for Halloween, showing 12 spooky films.

This was the second open air cinema we arranged this year and it was free for the public to sit on one of the deckchairs and enjoy the film.

## Farmers & Craft Markets

Happy Birthday to us! Our monthly Farmers & Craft Market has been running for one whole year!

Our market takes place on the last Sunday of every month from 10am-3pm along The Parade and attracts up to 40 stallholders. We run the market entirely in-house and we launched it to help with footfall on Sundays that were the quietest trading days in the town centre. We know that a good day out needs to cater for all ages so we also arrange entertainment at each market such as free face painting and walkabout characters. In October we arranged for witch stilt walkers and free face painting and for Sunday 26 November we have free facepainting and The Grinch & Cindy Lou.

## Graffiti Removal

We have organised and funded graffiti removal for the end of November. Councils do not remove graffiti from private land or buildings, so we have stepped in to ensure the town centre looks its best and we have contracted a specialist firm to clean up the graffiti. This will be the second time this year we have arranged for the graffiti removal. Please see our website for before / after photos.



## **Emergency Services Day**

In partnership with Sutton Coldfield Police, the ambulance service and fire brigade we hosted a family fun day with a fire engine, police car, police van, police dog and handler and police officers on hand to talk to shoppers. We arranged for free face painting, comedy police stilt walkers, a bubble-ologist and glitter art as free entertainment.

## **BID Marshals**

Last year we introduced SIA BID Security patrols every Friday and Saturday evening throughout December to ensure visitors and revellers enjoyed a safe seasonal night out. Feedback at the October Pubwatch meeting was that this initiative was extremely valuable for the pubs, bars and Police so we have organised and funded the BID Marshals to return this December.

## **MP Andrew Mitchell**

The BID Board met with MP Andrew Mitchell at local restaurant Chelo on Birmingham Road, to discuss concerns surrounding safety and security in the town centre, particularly surrounding CCTV. Mr Mitchell has followed this meeting up with a letter of support for us which we will present when we contact Sutton Coldfield Town Council and Birmingham City Council this month.
